### **RECOMMENDATION**

- 2. Approve the expenditure of District 2 office budget funds to purchase gift cards and other prizes not to exceed \$50 for a free raffle.
- 3. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses and/or community groups to support the event.
- 4. Place the items on the October 3, 2023, Council Agenda for action.

## **BACKGROUND**

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The District 2 Fall Festival will provide food, family friendly games, activities, health and wellness resources and community engagement to the residents of San José. The event will take place at Edenvale Garden Park, 200 Edenvale Ave, San Jose, CA 95136 on September 30, 2023. This event is free and open to the public
