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A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE ADOPTING THE CAPITOL CALTRAIN URBAN VILLAGE PLAN ADDENDUM TO THE ENVISION SAN JOSE 2040 GENERAL PLAN FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT, THE ENVISION SAN JOSE 2040 GENERAL PLAN SUPPLEMENTAL PROGRAM ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT, AS ADDENDED, ALL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT

WHEREAS, prior to the adoption of this Resolution, the Planning Director of the City of San José prepared an Addendum for the Capitol Caltrain Urban Village Plan, Planning File Nos. GP23-008, C23-109, C23-110, and ER23-225 (the "Addendum"), all in accordance with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, together with state and local guidelines implementing said Act, all as amended to date (collectively "CEQA"); and

WHEREAS, the Capitol Caltrain Urban Village Plan (the "Project") analyzed under the Addendum consists of a policy framework that will guide new job and housing growth within the Urban Village boundary; a General Plan Amendment and associated Conforming Rezonings; and will identify growth capacity for this Urban Village in the Envision San José 2040 General Plan, providing the capacity for the development of 100 new jobs (roughly 30,000 square feet of commercials space) and 700 new dwelling units; and

WHEREAS, the Addendum concluded that implementation of the Capitol Caltrain Urban Village Plan would not result in any substantial changes due to any new impacts not considered in the prior certified Envision San José 2040 General Plan Environmental Impact Report (Resolution No. 76041) and the Supplemental Environmental Impact Report (Resolution No. 77617), and all addenda thereto; and

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WHEREAS, the Addendum concluded that implementation of the Capitol Caltrain Urban

Village Plan would not result in any substantial increase in the severity of previously

identified significant effects in the prior certified Envision San José 2040 General Plan

Environmental Impact Report and the Supplemental Environmental Impact Report; and

WHEREAS, the Addendum concluded that implementation of the Caltrain Urban Village

Plan would not result in any substantial changes with respect to circumstances that will

require major revisions to the prior certified Envision San José 2040 General Plan

Environmental Impact Report and the Supplemental Environmental Impact Report; and

WHEREAS, the Addendum concluded that implementation of Caltrain Urban Village Plan

would not affect one or more significant effects discussed in the prior certified Envision

San José 2040 General Plan Environmental Impact Report and the Supplemental

Environmental Impact Report due to substantial new information or information of

substantial importance, and

WHEREAS, the Addendum concluded that implementation of the Caltrain Urban Village

Plan would not affect one or more significant effects previously examined that will be

substantially more severe than those disclosed in the prior certified Envision San José

2040 General Plan Environmental Impact Report and the Supplemental Environmental

Impact Report, and

WHEREAS, the City of San José is the lead agency on the Project, and the City Council

is the decision-making body for the proposed approval to undertake the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed and considered the Addendum for the Project

and intends to take actions on the Project in compliance with CEQA and state and local

guidelines implementing CEQA; and

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WHEREAS, the Addendum for the Project, the Envision San José 2040 General Plan

Environmental Impact Report, and Envision San José 2040 General Plan Supplemental

Environmental Impact Report are on file in the Office of the Director of Planning, Building

and Code Enforcement, located at 200 East Santa Clara Street, 3rd Floor Tower,

San José, California, 95113, are available for inspection by any interested person at that

location and on the Department of Planning, Building, and Code Enforcement's website

and are, by this reference, incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

SAN JOSE:

THAT THE CITY COUNCIL does hereby make the following findings: (1) it has

independently reviewed and analyzed the Addendum and other information in the record

and has considered the information contained therein, prior to acting upon or approving

the Project, (2) the Addendum prepared for the Project has been completed in compliance

with CEQA and is consistent with state and local guidelines implementing CEQA, and (3)

the Addendum represents the independent judgment and analysis of the City of San José,

as lead agency for the Project.

The City Council designates the Director of Planning, Building and Code Enforcement at

the Director's Office at 200 East Santa Clara Street, 3rd Floor Tower, San José,

California, 95113, as the custodian of documents and records of proceedings on which

this decision is based.

THAT THE CITY COUNCIL does hereby find that based upon the entire record of

proceedings before it and all information received that there is no substantial evidence

that the Project will have a significant effect on the environment and does hereby adopt

the Addendum prepared for the Project (Planning File Nos. GP23-008, C23-109, C23-

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110, and ER23-225). The Addendum is: (1) on file in the Office of the Director of Planning, Building and Code Enforcement, located at 200 East Santa Clara Street, 3rd Floor Tower, San José, California, 95113 and is posted to the Department of Planning, Building, and Code Enforcement's website and (2) available for inspection by any interested person.
