**SUBJECT: RETROACTIVELY APPROVE THE DUMPSTER DAY EVENT
SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 4 AS A CITY COUNCIL
SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT
DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT**

RECOMMENDATION

1. Retroactively approve the Dumpster Day event that occurred on February 1, 2020 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
2. Retroactively approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.
3. Place the item on the March 10th, 2020 City Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Dumpster Day event was held on February 1st, 2020 at Sierramont Middle School, 3155 Kimlee Drive, San Jose, 95132, sponsored by Councilmember Lan Diep. This special event was aimed at stemming illegal dumping. Several volunteers participated in the event. The event was free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Diep will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 4, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the

event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
