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A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE (1) APPROVING THE ANNUAL BUDGET REPORT FOR MAINTENANCE DISTRICT 18 (THE MEADOWLANDS) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026, AS FILED OR MODIFIED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, AND CONFIRMING AND LEVYING THE INDIVIDUAL ASSESSMENTS AS FILED OR MODIFIED BY CITY COUNCIL; AND (2) DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO DELIVER THE ASSESSMENT ROLL TO THE SANTA CLARA COUNTY FOR COLLECTION WITH THE PROPERTY TAXES

WHEREAS, on June 23, 1998, the City Council of San José ("City Council") adopted Resolution No. 68240, a Resolution providing for the establishment of the City of San José Maintenance District 18 (The Meadowlands) pursuant to the provisions of Municipal Code Chapter 14.15, referred to as the Alternative Procedures for Maintenance Districts, which was revised to conform to the requirements of California Proposition No. 218; and

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2007, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 74043, in accordance with the provisions of Municipal Code Chapter 14.15, referred to as the Alternative Procedures for Maintenance Districts, as revised to conform to the requirements of California Proposition No. 218, which is a Resolution amending Resolution No. 68240 to increase the current assessment and provide additional maintenance services for certain specified public improvements within the boundaries of City of San José Maintenance District 18 (The Meadowlands), with the assessment increase and additional maintenance services to commence in the 2008-2009 tax year; and

WHEREAS, because the proposed annual change in the assessment does not exceed the annual change in the San Francisco-Oakland-Hayward, CA Consumer Price Index, the Director of Public Works has prepared and filed with the City Clerk an Annual

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Budget Report for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 ("Annual Budget Report") according to the

requirements of Municipal Code Chapter 14.15; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget Report contains changes for the fiscal year, the

proposed budget, the annual levy, the assessment roll and assessment diagram; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the entirety of the administrative record,

including the Annual Budget Report, remedied and corrected any errors or informalities

in the Annual Budget Report, and revised and corrected any of the acts or

determinations of the various City officials as contained therein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN

JOSE THAT:

1. The Annual Assessment in the Annual Budget Report does not exceed the

average annual change in the San Francisco-Oakland-Hayward, CA Consumer

Price Index.

2. The Annual Budget Report and each of the assessments therein as duly revised

and corrected, are hereby approved, confirmed and adopted.

3. The levying of assessments in Maintenance District 18 (The Meadowlands) for

Fiscal Year 2025-2026 in accordance with this Resolution is hereby authorized.

4. The Annual Budget Report quantifies any general and/or special benefit

contribution required from the City. City staff is directed to pay any required City

contributions as set forth in the Annual Budget Report.

5. The Annual Budget Report together with the certification of the City Clerk as to

the place and date of approval by the City Council, shall forthwith be delivered to
