On behalf of the San Jose Chamber of Commerce, I would like to thank City staff for their work in preparing the 2026 Major Sports Events Status Report. The thoughtful planning underway represents an extraordinary opportunity for San Jose to leverage next year's global events as a springboard for future bids and long-term growth in our sports and entertainment economy.

The projected economic impact of hosting the Super Bowl, NCAA March Madness, and FIFA World Cup matches is estimated at \$400–\$500 million across Santa Clara County. We are encouraged to see a coordinated strategy that includes community activations such as watch parties and drone shows, robust branding and marketing efforts, broad engagement throughout the city, and a strong commitment to public safety.

We also recognize that major events come with significant costs for the City—particularly in infrastructure, security, and traffic management. To address these, we encourage continued pursuit of corporate sponsorships and public-private partnerships. In addition, we recommend the City establish an ongoing budget for special events, ensuring San Jose remains competitive in securing world-class opportunities while building a sustainable sports and entertainment economy.

The Chamber looks forward to serving as an active partner in delivering a successful 2026 and in strengthening San Jose's position as a premier sports and entertainment destination for years to come. Thank you for your leadership and consideration of our comments.
