RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Retroactively Approve the Dumpster Day scheduled on June 7, as a City Council-sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.
- 3. Place the item on the August 12, 2025 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council-sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Dumpster Day was held on June 7, 2025, at Cambrian Park Plaza and sponsored by Vice Mayor Pam Foley. This special event allows residents to drop off their household items for disposal. The event is free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Vice Mayor Pam Foley will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1).
