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What is Undergrounding?

20B	Private Developers	City of San José
	In-Lieu Undergrounding Fee at \$605 per linear foot of property frontage	
20C	Project Developer (public or private)	Developer and PG&E coordinate project -specific implementation that does not meet 20A or 20B criteria

Rule 20B Workplan



\$9 million Rule 20B fund balance in 2022

\$1 million projected revenue in the next five years from developer contributions to in-lieu fees

McKee/Jose Figueres Rule 20B Project is in design, expected to start July 2024

\$4.1 million fund balance projected for FY 2027-2028



Why Now?

California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) is sunsetting the Rule 20A program by June 2025.

CPUC is concerned about oversight, time to complete, and equity in utility undergrounding.

City's current Rule 20A credit is \$38 million but only \$17 million is legislated and secured before sunset.



The Opportunity




If we don't act now, we leave millions on the table when ratepayers have paid into the PG&E 20A pool for decades.

San José can legislate for the full \$59M Rule 20A Undergrounding work credits before they expire and target additional funds.

- \$21 million is unlegislated to maximize full \$38 million work credit
- +\$21 million additional unallocated funds from other jurisdictions can be pursued




\$59 million Opportunity
