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## **BACKGROUND**

## Rent Stabilization Program Strategic Plan Status Report

At its April 22, 2024, meeting, the CED Committee voted unanimously to drop the Rent Stabilization Program Strategic Plan Status Report from the April 22, 2024, meeting agenda and add it to the August 2024 CED Committee meeting agenda. During its discussion, the CED Committee expressed the desire to have the new Housing Director review the proposed Rent Stabilization Program Strategic Plan and offer potential modifications. This change necessitates removing the item from the January-June 2024 CED Committee Work Plan. The item will be included in the proposed August-December 2024 CED Committee Work Plan to be approved at the Rules and Open Government Committee.

# Lease and Asset Management System Status Report

Staff provided an update on the status of the Lease and Asset Management System as part of the January 22, 2024, CED Committee Real Estate Services Division Annual Report (<u>CC 24-272</u>). In coordination with the Information Technology Department, the Office of Economic Development and Cultural Affairs Real Estate Services Division is working to procure a real estate database software platform that will provide a comprehensive database for all City-owned properties. This database will be developed to allow for reporting on all vacant lands owned by the City.

Reporting on this work no longer requires a standalone CED Committee work plan item and will be included in the Real Estate Services Division Annual Report.

<u>Measure E Real Property Transfer Tax Refund for Qualifying Nonprofit Real Property Transfers Pilot Program Status Report</u>

At the June 20, 2023, City Council meeting staff recommended extending the Measure E Real Property Transfer Tax Refund for Qualifying Nonprofit Real Property Transfers Pilot Program (Pilot Program) for one year (CC 23-931). City Council voted to approve the staff recommendation and directed staff to report back to the CED Committee for further discussion, analysis, and decision on whether to sunset the pilot program.

During the past year, staff conducted two outreach meetings and initiated additional analysis. Given the unique circumstances in the past three years, including impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic which have led to current market conditions, staff recommends extending the pilot program. Due to the timing challenge of the pilot program sunsetting on June 30, 2024, staff
