SUBJECT: FALL INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS REPORT

RECOMMENDATIONS

Reaffirm all City positions summarized in the 2023 Intergovernmental Relations Priority State Legislation Log with the exception of: AB 12; AB 28; AB 251; AB 361; AB 367; AB 531; AB 875; AB 939; AB 1085; AB 1237; AB 1319; AB 1449; AB 1505; AB 1657; ACA 1; ACA 13; SB 8; SB91; SB 393; SB 400; SB 532; SB 567; and SB 634 to be deferred for a vote in January.

DISCUSSION

Thank you to the Intergovernmental Relations Team for all their hard work in preparing this report. It is no small feat providing an update on the top federal and state legislative items being tracked by our City. Of the 395 pieces of federal and state legislation being presented today, I would like to defer the vote on 23 state legislation items. These include AB 12; AB 28; AB 251; AB 361; AB 367; AB 531; AB 875; AB 939; AB 1085; AB 1237; AB 1319; AB 1449; AB 1505; AB 1657; ACA 1; ACA 13; SB 8; SB91; SB 393; SB 400; SB 532; SB 567; and SB 634, to be brought back in January 2024 to provide ample time to understand the intricacies of each. Within each of these 23 legislative bills there is considerable impact to our City and residents which warrants a thorough examination prior to City Council decision.
