RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a resolution declaring and recording a statement of the results of the November 8, 2022 General Municipal Election and Special Municipal Election per Elections Code Sections 10263, 10264, and 15400.

OUTCOME

The resolution will declare the results of the election, as certified by the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters, and record a statement of:

- That Measure I, the City of San José's Charter Amendment passed by majority vote;
 and
- That the following candidates received a majority of all votes cast for such office:
 - o Office of Councilmember—District 3: Omar Torres
 - o Office of Councilmember—District 5: Peter Ortiz
 - o Office of Councilmember—District 7: Bien Doan
 - o Office of the Mayor: Matt Mahan

BACKGROUND

The City Council adopted Resolution No. 80349 on January 25, 2022 calling for a Primary Municipal Election on June 7, 2022 and a Run-Off Election, if necessary, on November 8, 2022 to elect for the Office of the Mayor and one person each from Office of Councilmember for Council Districts 1, 3, 5, 7, and 9. The Resolution also requested that the County of Santa Clara Board of Supervisors consolidate the City's elections with the Statewide Primary and Statewide General Elections.

In addition, on June 14, 2022, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 80573, calling for a Special Municipal Election to be held on November 8, 2022 to place a measure on the ballot to amend a ballot measure proposal to amend the San José City Charter to add the City's ethics and elections commission (Board of Fair Campaign and Political Practices) to the Charter; (2) remove requirements that members of the Planning, Civil Service and Salary Setting Commissions be electors and/or citizens; (3) remove gender-specific language; and (4) require the City Council to adopt equity values, standards and assessments in making certain decisions.

All Municipal Elections were consolidated with the County of Santa Clara and held in accordance with established procedures governing the conduct of elections. Under the Elections Code, the County Registrar of Voters has thirty days to certify the results of an election. The City Clerk's Office received the official certification of results on December 8, 2022.

ANALYSIS

Of the 524,451 voters registered as of October 24, 2022, a total of 250,482 ballots were cast in the City of San Jose. The results as of December 2, 2022 are as follows:
