A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE RECITING THAT A REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION AND SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION WERE HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN JOSE ON TUESDAY, JUNE 5, 2026; STATING THE OFFICES TO BE FILLED AT THE ELECTION, AND CONFIRMING THE PASSAGE OF MEASURE A; FINDING AND DECLARING THAT THE REGISTRAR OF VOTERS OF THE COUNTY OF SANTA CLARA HAS CANVASSED THE RETURNS OF THE ELECTION AND CONFIRMING THE RESULTS OF THE CANVASS; STATING THE WHOLE NUMBER OF VOTES CAST, THE NAMES OF THE PERSONS AND OFFICES VOTED FOR, THE MEASURE VOTED FOR, THE NUMBER OF VOTES GIVEN AT EACH PRECINCT TO EACH PERSON AND FOR AND AGAINST EACH MEASURE; AND FINDING AND DECLARING WHO RECEIVED THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF VOTES OF THE VOTES CAST AND THE MEASURES THAT RECEIVED A MAJORITY OF THE VOTES CAST

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE:

SECTION 1. The Council of the City of San José hereby finds, determines, declares and recites that, in accordance with Article XVI of the San José City Charter, a regularly scheduled Primary Municipal Election and Special Municipal Election were held in the City of San José on Tuesday, June 5, 2026, for the purpose of electing one person each from Council Districts 1, 3, 5, 7, and 9 to the Council for full four-year terms; and submitting Measure A to the voters of the City of San José.

SECTION 2. The Registrar of Voters of Santa Clara County has duly canvassed the votes cast in the City of San José at the Municipal Elections on June 5, 2026, by the electors of the City for the offices and measures set forth, and has prepared a statement of all votes cast, and has certified the results of the votes cast at said elections for each

office and the measures, which said certification is now on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of San José.

SECTION 3. The Council of the City of San José hereby finds, determines and declares that said canvass is confirmed, and that the following are the results of said canvass and of said elections:

- (a) That the total number of ballots cast in the City of San José in said elections is set forth in the Certificates of Election Results, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference;
- (b) That the candidates who are declared elected to office, having received a majority of all votes cast for such office, are:

District 1: Rosemary Kamei

District 3: Anthony Tordillos

- (c) That the two candidates who will proceed to the Run-Off Municipal Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, having received the greatest number of votes in the Primary Municipal Election, but not a majority of all votes cast for such office, are:

District 5: Peter Ortiz and Nora Campos

District 7: Bien Doan and Van Le

District 9: Genny Altwor and Gordon Chester

- (d) That Measure A, "Transient Occupancy (Hotel) Tax," passed by a majority vote.

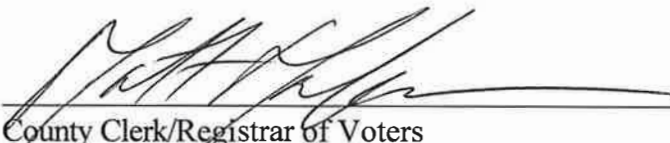

I, Matt Moreles, Registrar of Voters of the County of Santa Clara, State of California, hereby declare:

A Statewide Direct Primary Election was held in the County of Santa Clara, in the City of San José, on June 2, 2026 for the purpose of submitting the following measure to the voters:

A To fund essential city services including police and fire emergency response; address homeless encampments impacting parks, neighborhoods, and waterways, remove trash, illegal dumping, and graffiti; and maintain trails, playgrounds, recreational facilities, and park restrooms, shall an ordinance be adopted increasing the general fund transient occupancy (hotel) tax from 4% to 6%, generating approximately \$10 million annually, and paid by hotel/motel guests, until repealed by voters?

The official canvass of the returns of the election was conducted by the Office of the Registrar of Voters in accordance with the appropriate provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California.

The Statement of Votes Cast, now on file at my office, shows the whole number of votes cast for **Measure A** in each of the precincts and the total shown is true and correct.
