Pedestrian Safety Pilot at Monterey Rd. and Curtner Ave. (Esparza)

Recommendation:

- 1. Direct the City Manager to allocate resources for a dedicated homeless outreach effort to the encampments near the intersection of Monterey and Curtner, including coordinating with Destination: Home's Lived Experience Advisory Board and County's Community Mobile Response Program.
