SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF FAITH LEADER LUNCH SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 10 AS CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENTS TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENTS

RECOMMENDATION

1. Approve the District 10 Faith Leader Lunch on Thursday, September 27, 2018, as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.
3. Place the item on the August 14, 2018 Council Agenda for action.

SUMMARY

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517, which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Retroactively approve the District 10 Faith Leader Lunch.

The District 10 Faith Leader Lunch is a non-denominational community event scheduled on Thursday, September 27, 2018, and sponsored by Councilmember Johnny Khamis. This special event will host a celebration of community service to thank leaders from a spectrum of religious communities for their contributions, services and support to the residents in District 10, to share with them various non-profit homelessness programs to seek their partnership in caring for the homeless, and to hear and address their community concerns. This event was free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the events will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements,

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Councilmember Johnny Khamis will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the events on his Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 10, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the events. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
