BACKGROUND

Staff requests to drop the Regulation of Vape and Smoke Shops Status Report from the November 21, 2024, Public Safety, Finance, and Strategic Support Committee meeting to streamline efforts regarding vape and smoke shops. The Planning, Building, and Code Enforcement Department provided the Citywide Planning Activities Semi-Annual Status Report, including zoning ordinance changes to regulate vape and smoke shops, to the Community and Economic Development Committee on September 23, 2024, and to the City Council on October 22, 2024. Additionally, Code Enforcement intends to include an update on this work as part of the Flavored Tobacco Ban and Nitrous Oxide Status Report scheduled for June 12, 2025, on the January – June 2025 Neighborhood Services and Education Committee Work Plan.
