- (c) Return to Neighborhood Services and Education Committee in fall 2023 with a report on staff's Neighborhood Association Engagement Model.

Sunset the Neighborhoods Commission

- Inability to meet quorum at meetings on an ongoing and consistent basis due to high turnover
- There is a lack of participation and feedback loop with neighborhood associations and leaders often cite the lack of interaction and problem solving of neighborhood issues due to the Commission meeting format
- Doesn't adequately address issues from unrepresented and underrepresented neighborhoods




Restructure Timeline
