



- Covers Alum Rock and Little Portugal Urban Village areas






Creation of the Community Priorities Report

- "Community Priorities for the Alum Rock Corridor" (October 2020) → community priority identification






Community Priorities

- Increase Access to Affordable Housing
- Enhance Cleanliness and Safety of Parks, Streets, and Gardens
- Improve Pedestrian and Bicyclist Safety
- Decrease Vehicle Speeds
- Address Parking Shortages
- Make More Space for Recreation Centers and Outdoor Events and Festivals
- Expand Access to Open Space and Parks
- Increase Access to Grocery Stores, Farmers' Markets, and Outdoor Dining
- Offer More Youth and Teen Programming
- Support Local and Culturally Relevant Public Art
