**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE APPROVING (A) THE PROPOSED PROGRAMS PRESENTED IN THE SAN JOSE CLEAN ENERGY PROGRAMS ROADMAP UPDATE AND (B) AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR THEIR DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE CONTRACT(S) WITH CONSULTANT(S) TO THE ELECTRIC VEHICLE CONCIERGE AND HOME ELECTRIFICATION CONCIERGE SERVICES FOR UP TO 8 YEARS STARTING IN FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 AND UP TO \$5.2 MILLION FROM THE SAN JOSE CLEAN ENERGY OPERATING FUND (FUNDING FOR SUBSEQUENT YEARS WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS); (C) AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR THEIR DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH A CONSULTANT TO IMPLEMENT THE RESIDENTIAL ELECTRIC VEHICLE INCENTIVE PROGRAM FOR UP TO 4 YEARS STARTING IN FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 AND UP TO \$4 MILLION FROM THE SAN JOSE CLEAN ENERGY OPERATING FUND (FUNDING FOR SUBSEQUENT YEARS WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS); AND (D) AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR THEIR DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE CONTRACT(S) WITH COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATIONS AND CONSULTANTS TO IMPLEMENT THE EV AND HEAT PUMP EDUCATION PROGRAMS FOR UP TO 5 YEARS STARTING IN FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 AND UP TO \$1.25 MILLION FROM THE SAN JOSE CLEAN ENERGY OPERATING FUND (FUNDING FOR SUBSEQUENT YEARS WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS)**

**WHEREAS**, the City of San José (“City”) City Council desires to adopt this resolution for the reasons set forth in the memorandum, dated March 17, 2025, from the Director of Energy, Lori Mitchell, for the April 22, 2025, City Council meeting (“Memorandum”);

**NOW, THEREFORE,** BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

- A. The proposed programs presented in the San José Clean Energy Programs Roadmap update are hereby approved, and
- B. The City Manager or their designee is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute contract(s) with consultant(s) to implement the Electric Vehicle Concierge and Home Electrification Concierge services for up to 8 years starting in Fiscal Year 2025-2026 and up to \$5.2 million from the San José Clean Energy Operating Fund (funding for subsequent years will be subject to the appropriation of funds); and
- C. The City Manager or their designee is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute a contract with a consultant to implement the Residential Electric Vehicle Incentive program for up to 4 years starting in Fiscal Year 2025-2026 and up to \$4 million from the San José Clean Energy Operating Fund (funding for subsequent years will be subject to the appropriation of funds); and
- D. The City Manager or their designee is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute contract(s) with community-based organizations and consultants to implement the EV and Heat Pump Education programs for up to 5 years starting in Fiscal Year 2025-2026 and up to \$1.25 million from the San José Clean Energy Operating Fund (funding for subsequent years will be subject to the appropriation of funds).
