COMMUNITY OUTREACH FUNDS FOR SERVICE ORGANIZATION

RECOMMENDATION

Forward a recommendation to the City Council to approve a grant to the Rotary Club of San Jose Foundation.

BACKGROUND

Pursuant to <u>City Council Expenditure and Reimbursement Policy, Policy Number 0-38</u>, Section K "Grants," Item 6 "Any contribution to an organization proposed by the Mayor or a Councilmember who is a member of, or receiving services from, that organization must be approved in advance by the City Council." I am a member of the San Jose Rotary Club.

Approval is requested to expend \$400 from the budgeted District 6 Community Outreach allocation to support the Rotary Club of San Jose Foundation. Foundation funds are used to support community service projects improving health, providing quality education, and improving the environment.
