## **BACKGROUND**

Pursuant to [City Council Expenditure and Reimbursement Policy, Policy Number 0-38](#), Section K “Grants,” Item 6 “Any contribution to an organization proposed by the Mayor or a Councilmember who is a member of, or receiving services from, that organization must be approved in advance by the City Council.” I am a member of the San Jose Rotary Club.

Approval is requested to expend \$400 from the budgeted District 6 Community Outreach allocation to support the Rotary Club of San Jose Foundation. Foundation funds are used to support community service projects improving health, providing quality education, and improving the environment.

The Rotary Club of San Jose Foundation is in Active and Good Standing Status with the California Secretary of State and California Franchise Tax Board, and in Current Status with the California Attorney General Registry of Charities and Fundraisers.
