The last minute proposed map would move Booksin Elementary, Presentation High, Saint Christopher's, Wallenberg Park, Willow Glen Middle School, Willow Glen High School, and surrounding streets.

This proposal was never vetted during the 42 hours of public meetings during the city's redistricting commission process.

Dividing Willow Glen, which at one time was its own incorporated city, is completely unnecessary. There is also no practical reason to make this change since population between council districts has already been balanced within the allowed deviation.

The Willow Glen Neighborhood Association is opposed to changing boundary lines in Willow Glen.
