

## Background



**November 2023:** City Council directed staff to negotiate a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA)



The MOU aims to formalize coordination for addressing blight and homeless encampments on adjacent properties

### Key Elements

#### **Coordinated Clean-Ups**

Joint responsibility to address and reduce blight. BeautifySJ and VTA will coordinate and collaborate to address blight promptly, reduce repeat offenders and streamline resource use

#### **Resource Sharing**

To better address the areas impacted by ongoing blight and encampments, both agencies agree to share resources, data, and expertise, which will allow for a quicker and more strategic response

#### Regular Communication

Scheduled meetings to allow for regular communication to address ongoing challenges, prioritization of coordinated work, and finalize the logistics of upcoming clean-ups
