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Dear City Council,

We are writing to strongly endorse and express much appreciation for considering installing restricted parking signs:

(a) Adopt a resolution authorizing the removal of large vehicles parked or left standing in violation of “**no large vehicle parking zones**” on the following streets or portions of streets:

(1) West side of Boynton Avenue, between Blackford Avenue and Underwood Drive;

- We have three schools on this section of the street.
- The campers, RVs, big rig trucks often with "sleeper cabs", box trucks, etc. can be a hazard for the school children as well as pedestrians and cars trying to exit from school and home driveways. They impede the view of oncoming cars.
- It also poses a risk for people to be pulled into the vehicles and hidden from view.
- Campers have often set up a "living room" on the sidewalk.
- Big rigs have often "warmed up" their engines for 5, 10, 15 minutes or more adding to the pollution for the school children and neighborhood.
- And of course it creates blight and detracts from the attractiveness of our neighborhood and is likely over time to lower our property value for the taxpaying residents on the street.

We would be most grateful for your vote to install and enforce the “**no large vehicle parking zones**” on **(1) West side of Boynton Avenue, between Blackford Avenue and Underwood Drive.**
