**SUBJECT**: CODE ENFORCEMENT PROCESS AND STATUS OF PROPERTY BLIGHT ABATEMENT

## RECOMMENDATION

Set a City Council Study Session entitled *Code Enforcement Process and Blight Abatement of Properties*.

## **PURPOSE**

A Study Session detailing code enforcement processes and blight abatement allows the City Council to learn about the code enforcement process, ask code enforcement and other department staff questions, and discuss changes potentially needed to improve the process regarding historically neglected and blighted buildings.
