WHEREAS, in August 2007, consistent with the Property and Business Improvement

District Law of 1994, Section 36600 et. seq. of the California Streets and Highways

Code and provisions of Article XIIID of the State Constitution (collectively, "PBID Laws"),

the City Council of the City of San José ("City Council") formed a property and business

improvement district ("PBID") in Downtown San José for an initial five-year term which

expired on December 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, in June 2012, the City Council expanded and renewed the PBID for an

additional ten-year term which expires on December 31, 2022, and must be renewed if

the property assessment and the enhanced services are to continue; and

WHEREAS, to initiate the process to expand and renew the PBID requires petitions be

signed by property owners in the PBID who will pay more than fifty percent of the

assessment proposed to be levied; and

WHEREAS, the City has received petitions from property owners within the PBID other

than the City that represent more than fifty percent of the assessment proposed to be

levied; and

WHEREAS, properties in the PBID owned by the City of San José represent

approximately sixteen percent (16%) of the total assessment; and

WHEREAS, as a show of support for the expansion and renewal of the PBID, the City
