**SUBJECT: RETROACTIVE APPROVAL OF TRASH TALKS SPONSORED BY
COUNCIL DISTRICT 6 AS CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL
EVENTS TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF
MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT**

RECOMMENDATION

1. Retroactively approve the community office hours Trash Talk that were held on March 19 and April 2, 2022 as City Council sponsored Special Events and approve the expenditure of funds.
2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups that supported the events.
3. Place the item on the April 12, 2022 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Trash Talks were held on March 19 at 454 Auzerais Avenue and April 2, 2022 at 1398 West San Carlos Street and were sponsored by Councilmember Dev Davis. These special events were an opportunity for residents to chat with Councilmember Dev Davis and her staff while cleaning-up the streets of District 6. The events were free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the events will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure
