San Jose Police Department Crime Statistics by Council District

Crime statistics will be summarized and provided by count by City Council Districts

Will provide meaningful data about public safety for the community

The data will be cumulative, from NIBRS April 2023 – current submission progress

The dashboard will be interactive and can be refined by viewers

• Viewers will be able to filter by month and NIBRS crime types for specific City Council Districts

San Jose Police Department Crime Statistics by Council District - Challenges


Crime statistics are extracted directly from RMS based on 52 data points, none of which capture location according to Council Districts

Will require an entirely new data extraction method

Crime Analysis Unit will manually extract the data, sort it based on location, and add it to the dashboard.

New data extraction method is in the early phase of development
