San José Police Department

BERRYESSA BART STATION

- 23,000 daily passengers projected a day (doubled in 15 years).
- 10-car trains arrive every 7.5 minutes.
- 7-story parking garage plus surface lot (1527 spaces total).
- VTA bus transit center with Express Bus service to Downtown San Jose (28 buses per hour).
- On-site bicycle paths and indoor bicycle storage room.

Hours of Operation: Weekdays (4:00 am - Midnight)
Saturday (6:00 am - Midnight)
Sunday (8:00 am - Midnight)
7 Days a Week/365 Days a year



TIMELINE

- March 15, 2019: RFP Issued.
- March 22, 2019: Pre-Proposal Conference & Site Tour.
- March 25, 2019: Deadline to Submit Questions.
- April 18, 2019: Deadline to Submit Proposal.
- April 23 & 24, 2019: Interviews by VTA, if necessary.
- May-July 2019: Bids awarded by VTA.
- May-July 2019: If awarded, report back to City Council for approval.



QUALIFICATIONS

- Costs for services to be charged competitively, including at or below full cost recovery.
- BART Station: SJPD jurisdiction including the surrounding neighborhoods.
 - Consistent safety priorities for both the station and the surrounding area.
 - Avoids duplication of police services and responses.
 - Law enforcement accountability in our own city.
 - Policies/procedures/training and use of force are consistent.
- SJPD is the largest Police Department in Santa Clara County.
 - Response times are minimized.
 - Patrol officers available.
 - Special Operations Unit.
 - Community Service Officers.



RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to submit a proposal to the Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) for Supplemental Law Enforcement Services for the Berryessa/North San Jose BART station area with costs for services to be charged competitively, including at or below full cost recovery.
