A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AND THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO, ACTING AS FISCAL AGENT FOR THE BAY AREA URBAN AREAS SECURITY INITIATIVE, TO ACCEPT THE 2020 UASI GRANT ALLOCATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,560,786, AND TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE ADDITIONAL AMENDMENTS AND RELATED DOCUMENTS WITHOUT FURTHER CITY COUNCIL ACTION

WHEREAS, on April 22, 2020, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security released its 2020 Homeland Security Grant Program Notice of Funding Opportunity, which includes the Fiscal Year 2020 Urban Areas Security Initiative (“UASI”) grant award for the Bay Area; and

WHEREAS, the UASI Approval Authority, a governing body approved by the Governor’s Office of Emergency Services (“Cal OES”) and composed of appointed representatives from Bay Area cities and counties as well as a Cal OES representative, authorizes the submission of spending plans and the allocation of grant funding to the Bay Area UASI to public agencies throughout the region, and the City and County of San Francisco acts as the fiscal agent for the Bay Area UASI; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Jose (“City”) was awarded a UASI grant of \$1,560,786 that will be used for organizational support for the City’s Office of Emergency Management and for communications systems support activities, technology capability improvements, and equipment purchases for the City’s Police Department and Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to execute an agreement, which will be effective from November 1, 2020 through December 31, 2021, with the City and County of

San Francisco that will enable the City to continue to prepare for, respond to, and recover from potential incidents of terrorism and other hazards through a regional collaboration of local jurisdictions around the San Francisco Bay Area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement between the City of San José and the City and County of San Francisco, acting as fiscal agent for the Bay Area Urban Areas Security Initiative, to accept the 2020 UASI grant allocation in the amount of \$1,560,786, and to negotiate and execute additional amendments and related documents without further City Council action.
