Please note that <u>beginning Tuesday, February 6, 2024, the City of San José will limit verbal public comments for</u> <u>meetings of such Brown Act Bodies to in person only.</u> The public will still be able to watch live broadcasts of meetings of City Council on YouTube, PrimeGov, Zoom, and via Comcast Cable Channel 26. Zoom will continue to have Closed Captions are available on YouTube.
