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A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE ADOPTING AN ADDENDUM **ENVISION SAN JOSE 2040 GENERAL PLAN FINAL** ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT AND SUPPLEMENTAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT, ADDENDED: AS AND FINAL SUPPLEMENTAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT FOR THE UPDATED **EVERGREEN-EAST HILLS DEVELOPMENT POLICY; FOR** AN AMENDMENT TO THE EVERGREEN-EAST HILLS DEVELOPMENT POLICY TO LIMIT APPLICATION OF THE POLICY AND AN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 14.33 OF TITLE 14 OF THE SAN JOSE MUNICIPAL CODE TO LIMIT THE APPLICATION OF THE EVERGREEN-EAST HILLS DEVELOPMENT POLICY TRAFFIC IMPACT FEE, ALL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE **CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT**

WHEREAS, prior to the adoption of this Resolution, the Director of Planning, Building and Code Enforcement of the City of San José prepared an Addendum for an amendment to the Evergreen-East Hills Development Policy (EEHDP) and an amendment to Title 14 of the San José Municipal Code, Planning File No. GPT23-006 (the "Addendum"), all in accordance with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, together with state and local guidelines implementing said Act, all as amended to date (collectively "CEQA"); and

WHEREAS, the Project analyzed under the Addendum consists of the following:

(a) Amendment to the EEHDP to limit the application of the EEHDP to projects that received an approved entitlement (general plan amendment and/or zoning amendment) and/or a land use permit from the effective date of the EEHDP to the effective date of the resolution to close the EEHDP, making the Evergreen-East Hills Traffic Impact Fee inapplicable to Evergreen-East Hills development projects after the effective date of the resolution closing the policy; and

(b) Adoption of an ordinance amending San José Municipal Code Title 14, Chapter

14.33, entitled "Evergreen-East Hills Development Policy Traffic Impact Fee

Requirements," to limit the application of Chapter 14.33 to projects that received

an approved entitlement (general plan amendment and/or zoning amendment)

and/or a land use permit from the effective date of the EEHDP to the effective

date of the related resolution amending the EEHDP to close the policy, making

the Evergreen-East Hills Traffic Impact Fee inapplicable to future Evergreen-East

Hills development projects; and

(c) Changes to improvements identified as mitigation measures in the Evergreen-

East Hills Vision Strategy Project Final Environmental Impact Report and Final

Supplemental Environmental Impact Report for the Updated Evergreen-East

Hills Area Development Policy; and

WHEREAS, the amendments to the EEHDP and the Traffic Impact Fee are to limit the

application of the EEHDP and the Traffic Impact Fee to development within the Policy

area boundary that received approved land use entitlements, including any general plan

amendment and/or zoning amendment, and/or land use permits on or after the effective

date of the EEHDP, and prior to the effective date of the resolution making such an

amendment the EEHDP, and any subsequent amendments or adjustments to such

entitlements and/or land use permits; and

WHEREAS, the amendment to the General Plan makes changes to acknowledge the

amendments to the EEHDP; and

WHEREAS, the amendment to the San José Municipal Code Title 14, Chapter 14.33,

entitled "Evergreen-East Hills Development Policy Traffic Impact Fee Requirements," to

limit the application of Chapter 14.33 to projects that received an approved entitlement

(general plan amendment and/or zoning amendment) and/or a land use permit from the

effective date of the EEHDP to the effective date of the related resolution amending the

EEHDP to close the policy, making the Evergreen-East Hills Traffic Impact Fee

inapplicable to future Evergreen-East Hills development projects; and

WHEREAS, changes to improvements identified as mitigation measures in the

Evergreen-East Hills Vision Strategy Project Final Environmental Impact Report and Final

Supplemental Environmental Impact Report for the Updated Evergreen-East Hills Area

Development Policy; and

WHEREAS, the Addendum concluded that implementation of the Project would not result

in any substantial changes due to any new impacts not considered in the prior certified

Envision San José 2040 General Plan Environmental Impact Report (Resolution No.

76041) and the Supplemental Environmental Impact Report (Resolution No. 77617), and

all addenda thereto; and the Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Report for the

Updated Evergreen-East Hills Area Development Policy, adopted by City Council

(Resolution No. 74742), and addenda thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Addendum concluded that implementation of the Project would not result

in any substantial increase in the severity of previously identified significant effects in the

prior certified Envision San José 2040 General Plan Environmental Impact Report and

the Supplemental Environmental Impact Report; and the Final Supplemental

Environmental Impact Report for the Updated Evergreen-East Hills Area Development

Policy, and addenda thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Addendum concluded that implementation of the Project would not result

in any substantial changes with respect to circumstances that will require major revisions

to the prior certified Envision San José 2040 General Plan Environmental Impact Report

and the Supplemental Environmental Impact Report; and the Final Supplemental

Environmental Impact Report for the Updated Evergreen-East Hills Area Development

Policy, and addenda thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Addendum concluded that implementation of the Project would not affect

one or more significant effects discussed in the prior certified Envision San José 2040

General Plan Environmental Impact Report and the Supplemental Environmental Impact

Report, or the Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Report for the Updated

Evergreen-East Hills Area Development Policy, and addenda thereto, due to substantial

new information or information of substantial importance; and

WHEREAS, the Addendum concluded that implementation of the Project would not affect

one or more significant effects previously examined that will be substantially more severe

than those disclosed in the prior certified Envision San José 2040 General Plan

Environmental Impact Report and the Supplemental Environmental Impact Report; and

the Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Report for the Updated Evergreen-East

Hills Area Development Policy, and addenda thereto; and

WHEREAS, the City of San José is the lead agency on the Project, and the City Council

is the decision-making body for the proposed approval to undertake the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed and considered the Addendum for the Project

and intends to take actions on the Project in compliance with CEQA and state and local

guidelines implementing CEQA; and

WHEREAS, the Addendum for the Project, the Envision San José 2040 General Plan

Environmental Impact Report, Envision San José 2040 General Plan Supplemental

Environmental Impact Report, and the Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Report

for the Updated Evergreen-East Hills Area Development Policy, are on file in the Office

of the Director of Planning, Building and Code Enforcement, located at 200 East Santa

Clara Street, 3rd Floor Tower, San José, California, 95113, are available for inspection

by any interested person at that location and on the Department of Planning, Building,

and Code Enforcement's website and are, by this reference, incorporated into this

Resolution as if fully set forth herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

SAN JOSE:

THAT THE CITY COUNCIL does hereby make the following findings: (1) it has

independently reviewed and analyzed the Addendum and other information in the

administrative record and has considered the information contained therein, prior to acting

upon or approving the Project, (2) the Addendum prepared for the Project has been

completed in compliance with CEQA and is consistent with state and local guidelines

implementing CEQA, and (3) the Addendum represents the independent judgment and

analysis of the City of San José, as lead agency for the Project.

The City Council designates the Director of Planning, Building and Code Enforcement at

the Director's Office at 200 East Santa Clara Street, 3rd Floor Tower, San José,

California, 95113, as the custodian of documents and records of proceedings on which

this decision is based.

THAT THE CITY COUNCIL does hereby find that based upon the entire record of

proceedings before it and all information received that there is no substantial evidence

that the Project will have any new significant effect on the environment and does hereby

adopt the Addendum prepared for the Project (Planning File No. GPT23-006). The

Addendum is: (1) on file in the Office of the Director of Planning, Building and Code

Enforcement, located at 200 East Santa Clara Street, 3rd Floor Tower, San José,

California, 95113 and is (2) available for inspection by any interested person.
