SUBJECT: Update to the January – June 2025 Community and Economic Development Committee Work Plan

RECOMMENDATION

Approve an amendment to the January – June 2025 Community and Economic Development Committee Work Plan to:

Housing Stabilization and Eviction Prevention Status Report. <u>Purpose:</u> Provide a status report on housing stabilization and eviction prevention efforts to resolve active and potential unlawful detainer (eviction) court cases by preventing unnecessary forced evictions involving unpaid rent and promoting housing stability. (Housing)
