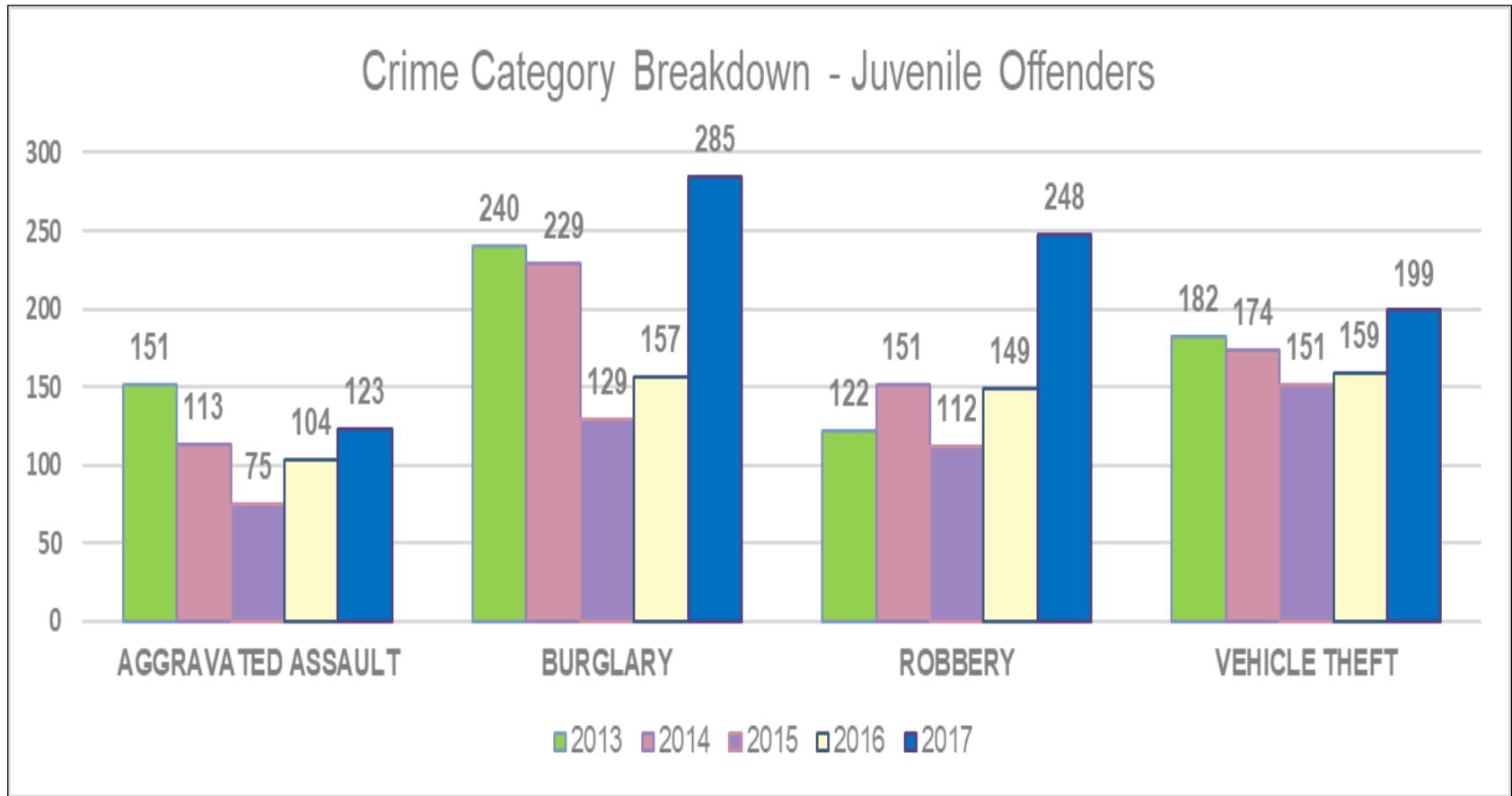

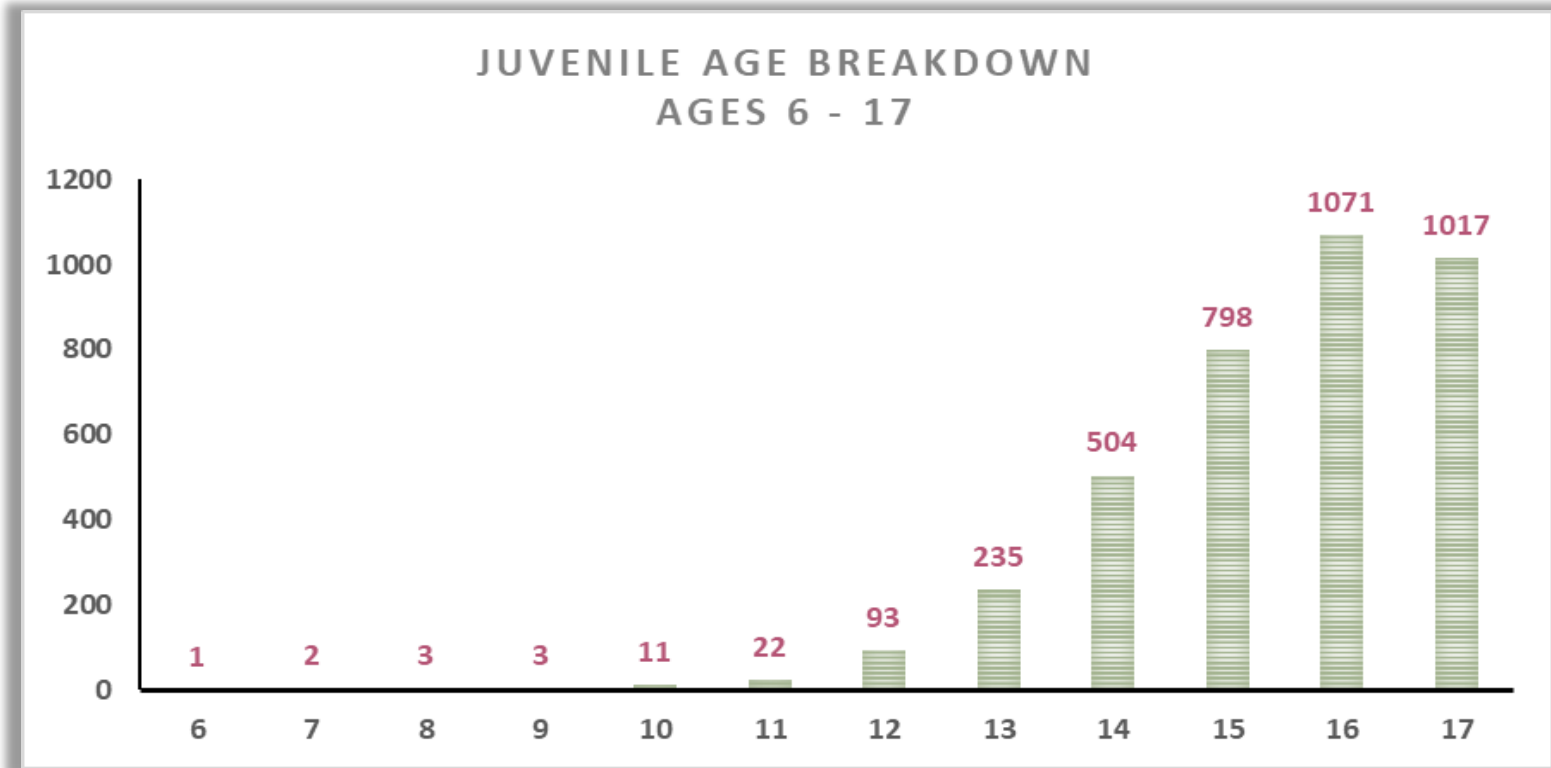
- Of the 46,472 offenders, 3,760 (8.1%) were juvenile offenders (confirmed by a DOB) and 2,868 (76.3%) of them were arrested or cited.

Juvenile Offenders – Age Breakdown January 2013 – August 2018

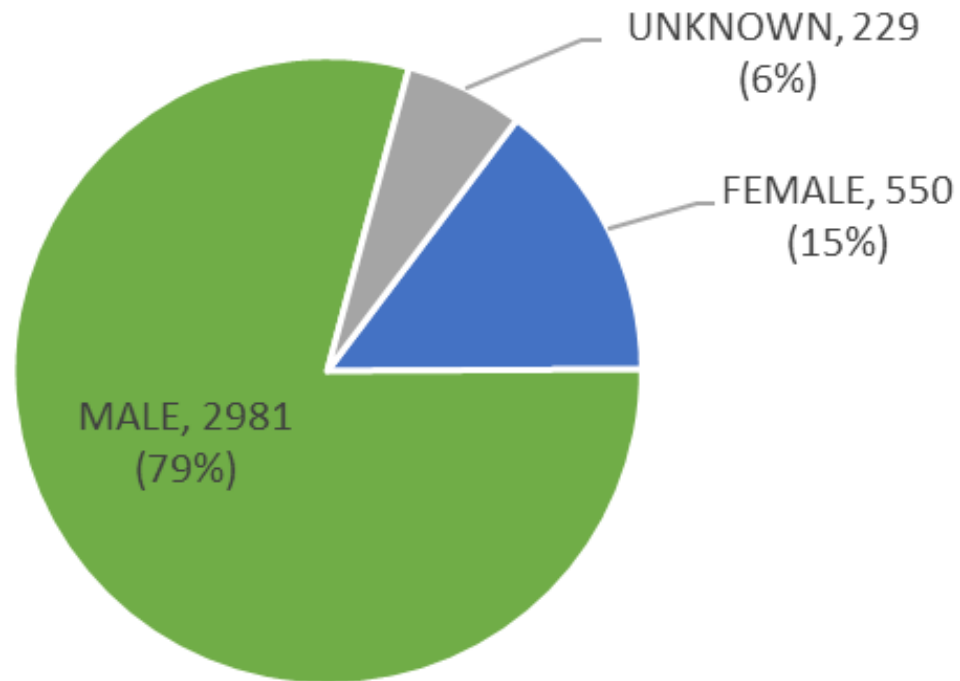


- Where the age of the offender is known, 96% fall between the ages of 13-17.
- Juvenile offenders, aged 10 and under - involved in burglary and aggravated assault incidents; those involved in burglaries participated with older siblings.

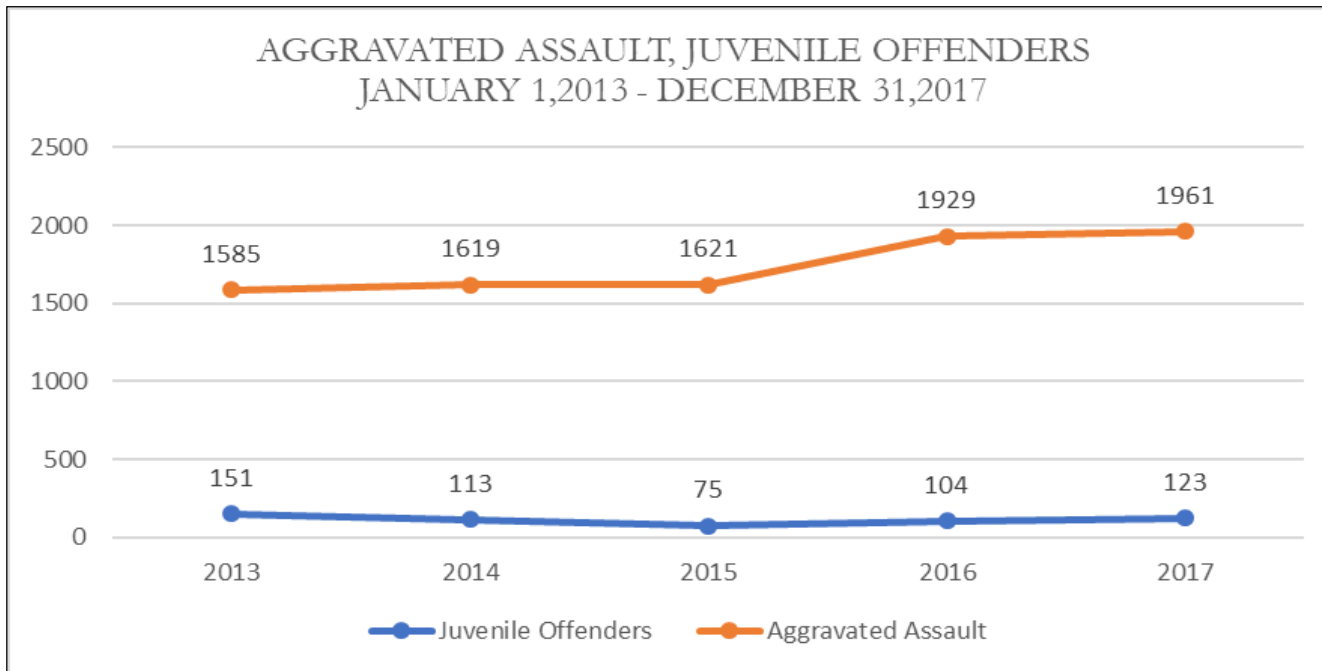

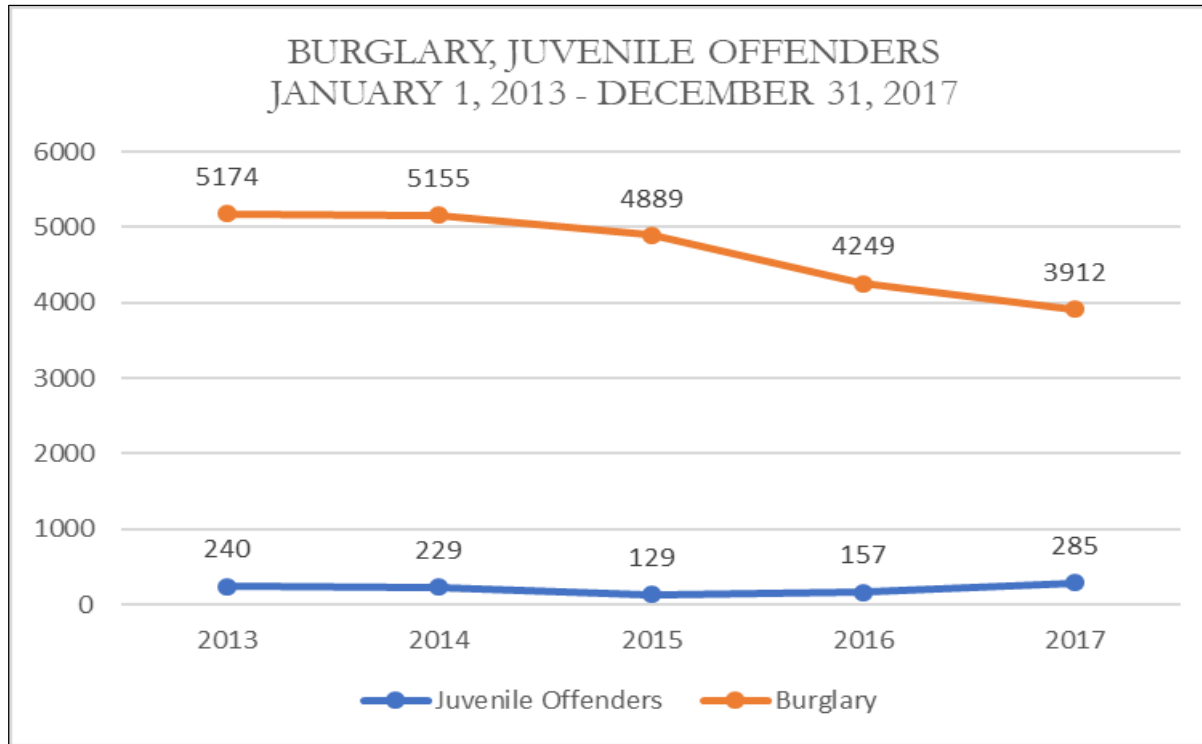

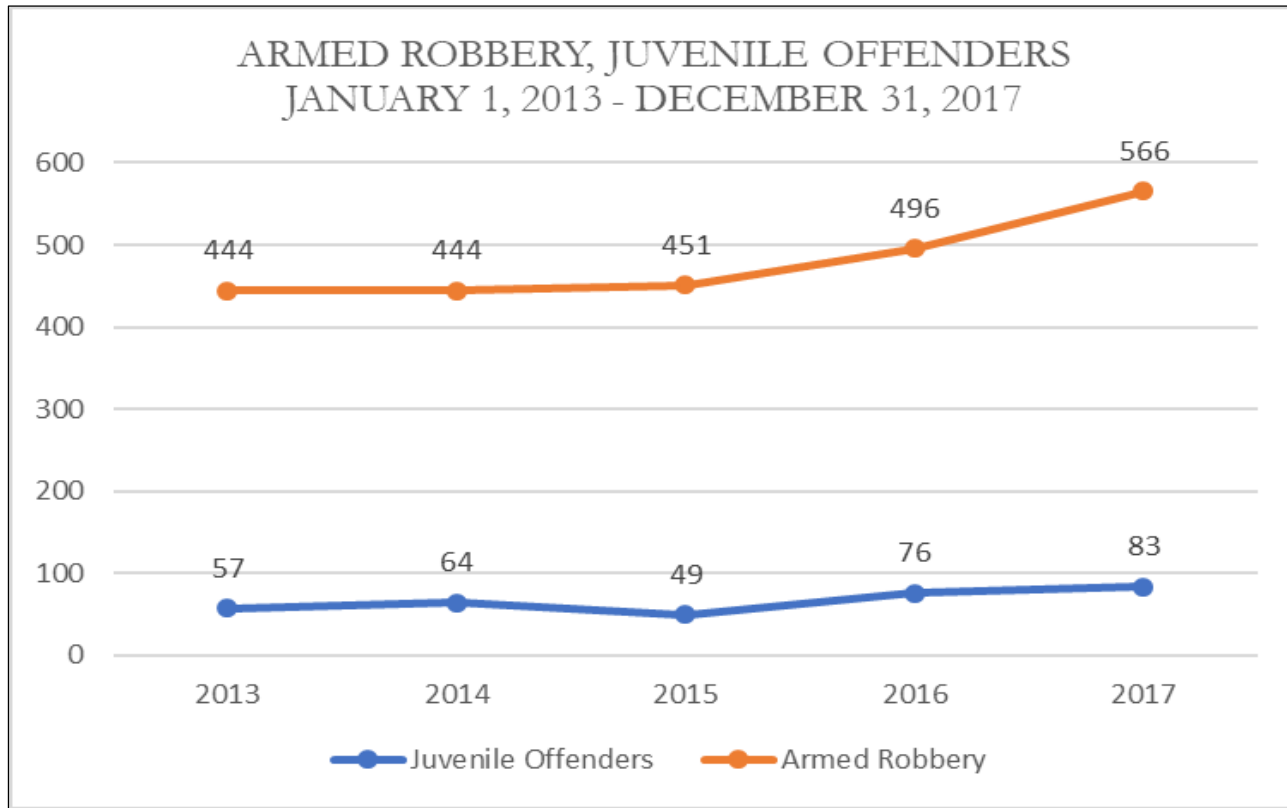

Armed Robbery

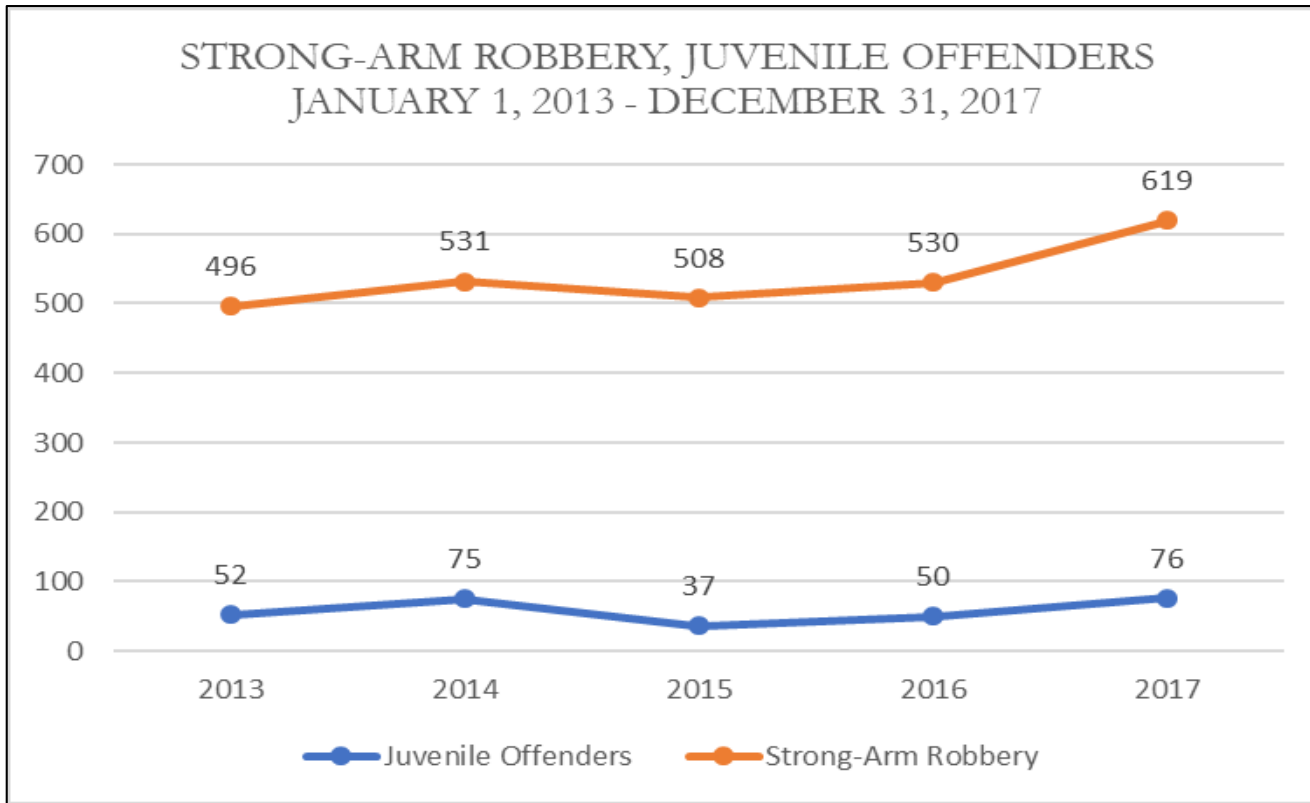

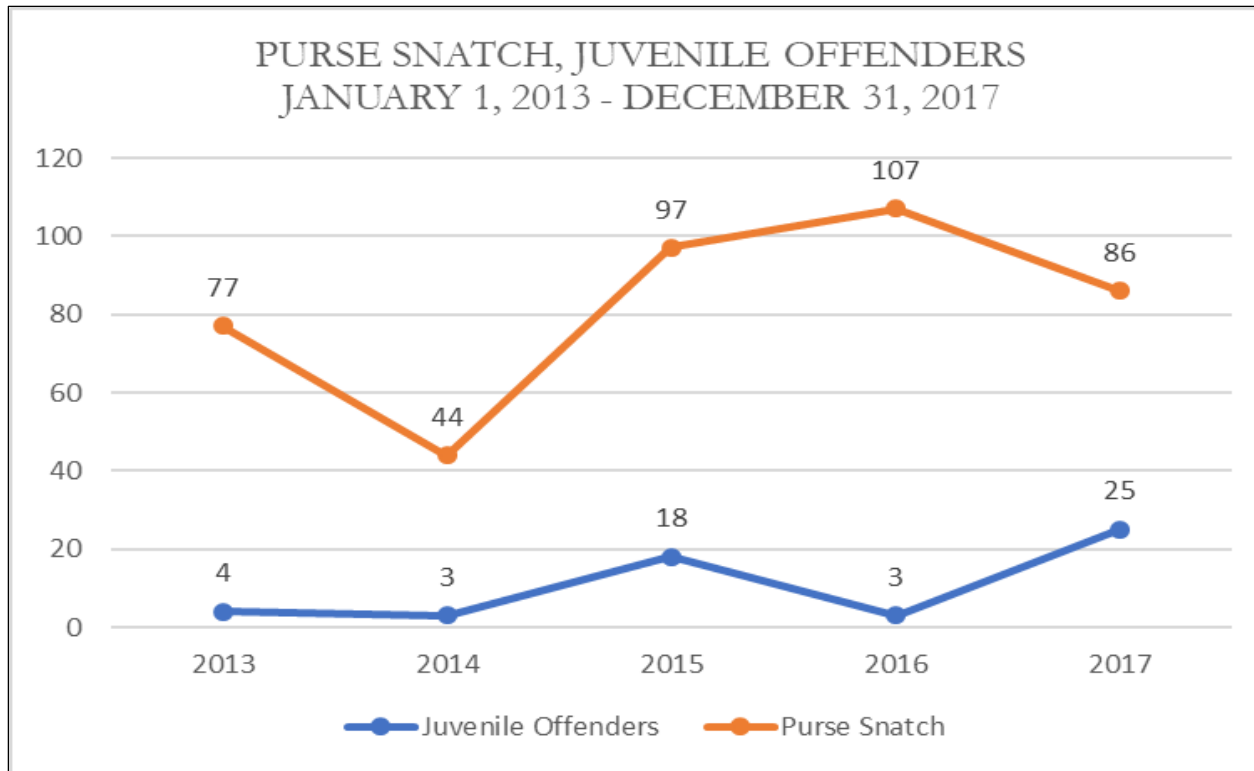

Purse Snatch Robbery

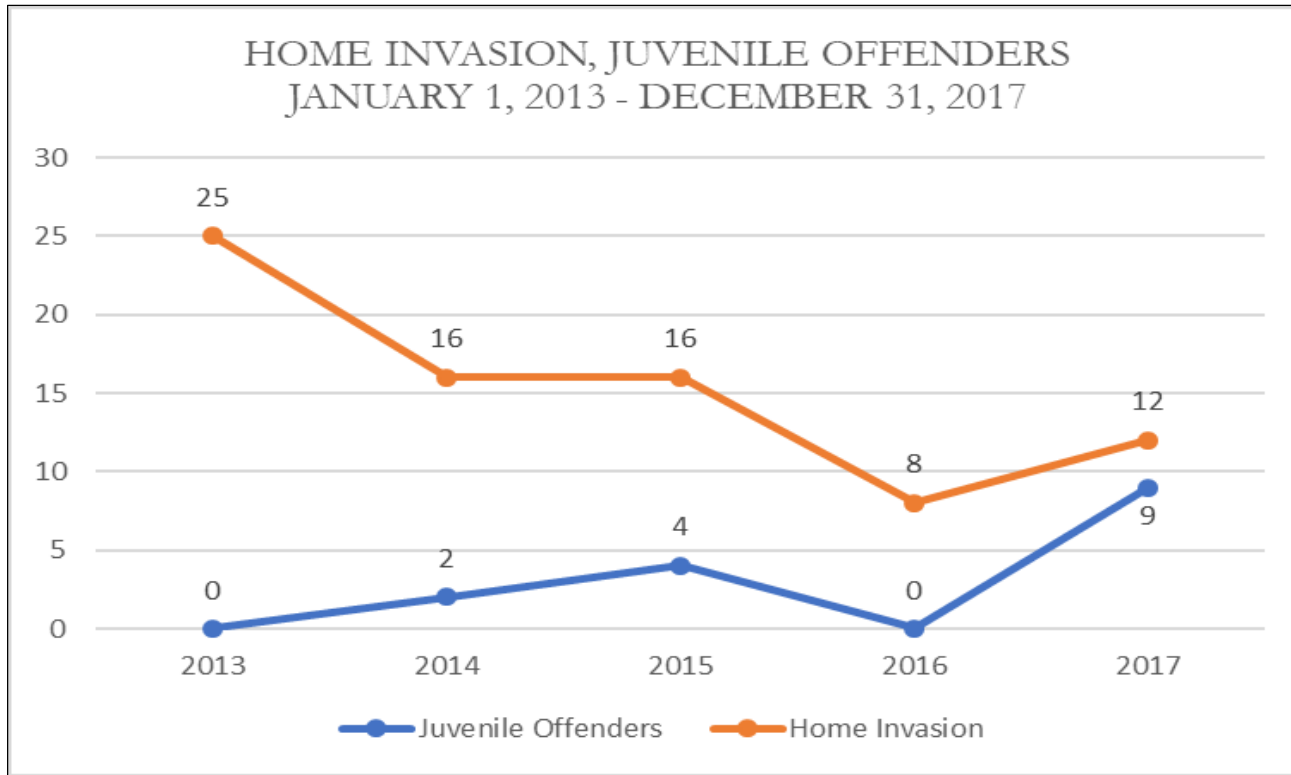

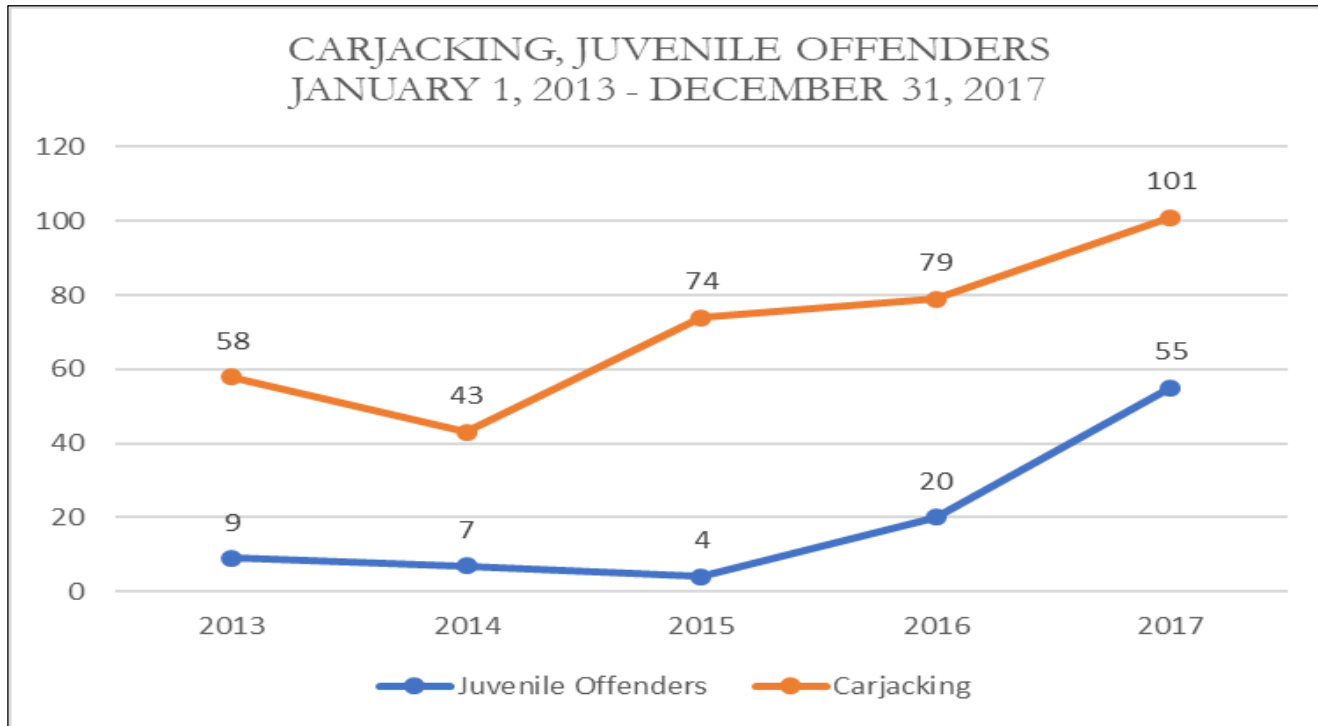

Carjacking

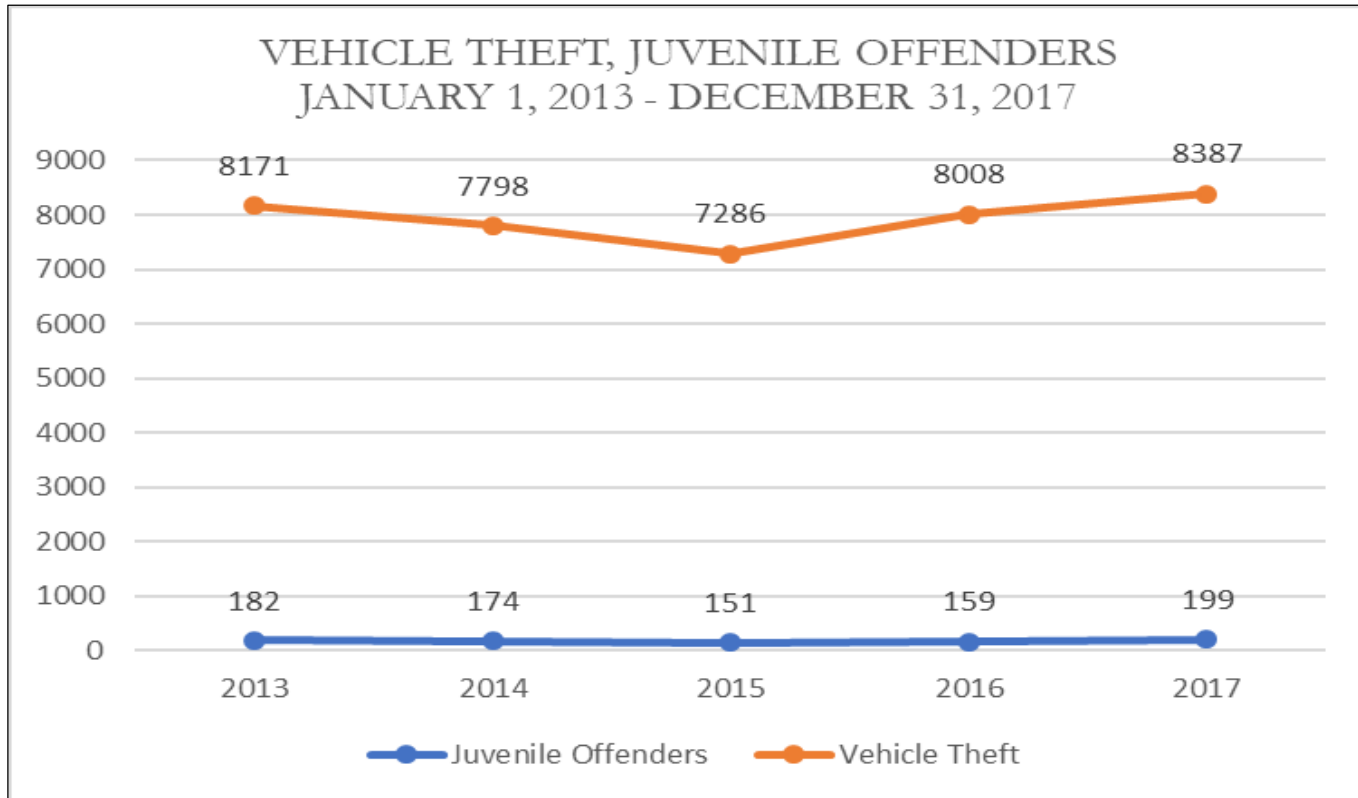

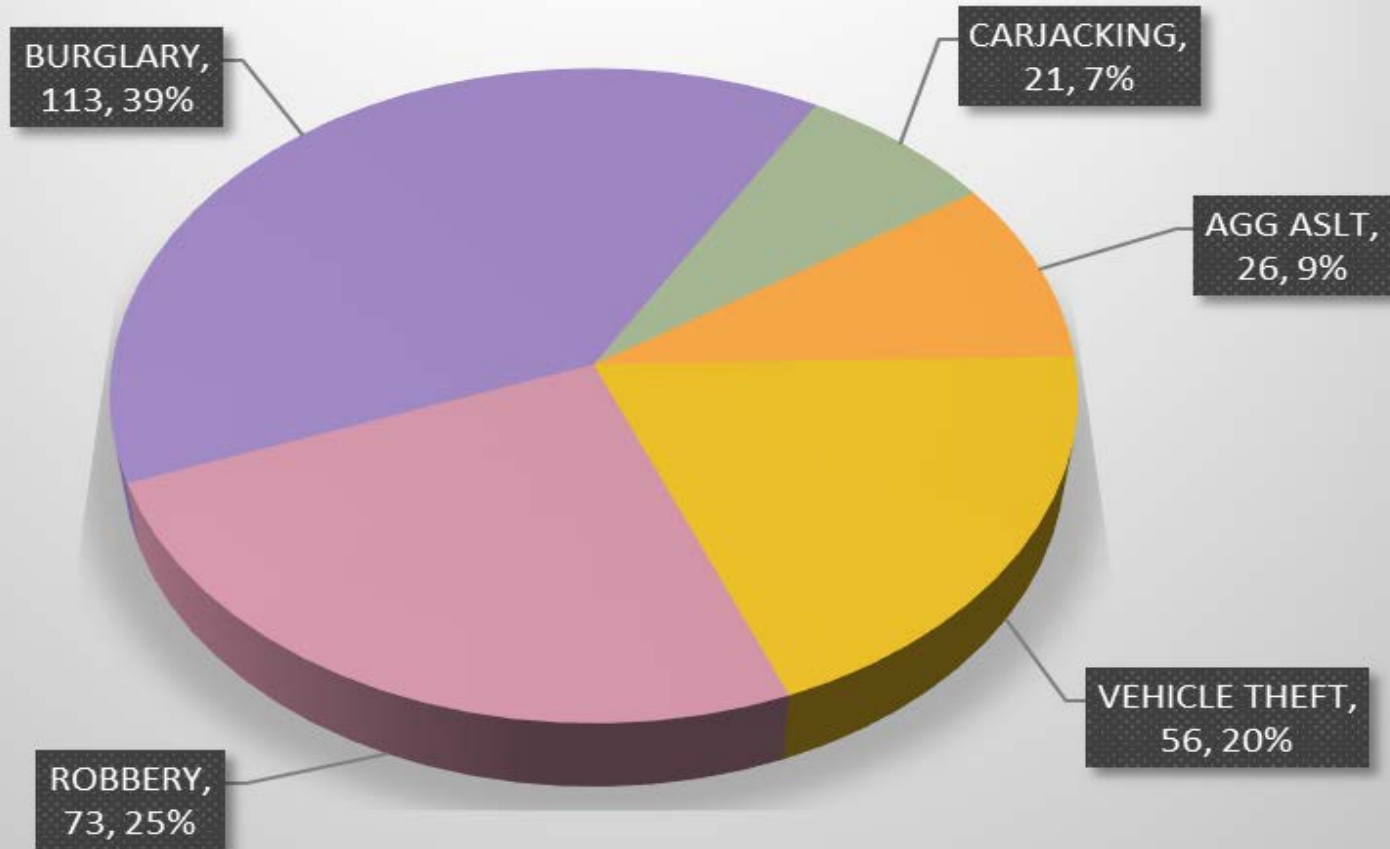
Number of Juvenile Offenders who used firearms by age & crime type

Re-offense Analysis Conducted by SJPD January 2017-August 2018

- Analyzed data for juveniles with two or more arrests for robbery, carjacking, home invasion robbery, assault with a deadly weapon, attempted murder, auto theft, burglary, and firearm offenses.
 - 1179 incidents committed by 667 identified juveniles
 - 206 offenders (30.9%) committed two or more unduplicated offenses

Takeaways

- Juvenile crime is on the rise
- SJPD involved with a High Risk Youth Committee
 - SJPD, Probation, & other justice system partners looking at most high risk youth to develop individually tailored approach
- Probation Officers at SJPD
 - 1 Supervisor and 4 Probation Officers at SJPD, working with BOI to identify offenders, help with investigations, and provide “early intervention” in cases
