SUBJECT: Actions Related to the Purchase Orders with Bayscape Management, Inc., Brightview Landscape Services, Inc., and New Image Landscape Company for Landscape Maintenance Services

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager or her designee to:

- (a) Execute purchase orders for landscape maintenance services with Bayscape Management, Inc. (Alviso, CA) for Community Facilities Districts 1, 11, 16, Maintenance Districts 1, 8, 13, 19, 20, and 22; and with Brightview Landscape Services, Inc. (Blue Bell, PA) for Community Facilities District 8, Maintenance Districts 9, 15, General Fund Contractual, General Fund Light Rail Transit, and Beautify San José areas; and with New Image Landscape Company (Fremont, CA) for Community Facilities Districts 2/3 and 12 beginning on or about July 1, 2025, and ending on or about June 30, 2026, for a combined not-to-exceed amount of \$5,000,000; and
- (b) Approve a contingency of \$1,000,000 for unanticipated landscaping maintenance and related services subject to the appropriation of funds; and
- (c) Exercise up to six one-year options to extend the term of the purchase orders, with the last option ending on or about June 30, 2032, subject to the appropriation of funds.

BASIS FOR RECOMMENDATION

The City's Department of Transportation (DOT) is responsible for landscape maintenance for public right-of-way areas (public throughways) located within the City's special districts and general fund areas. This includes street median islands, park strips, pocket parks, and frontages planted with enhanced landscaping such as turf, trees, shrubs, and annual plants. Special district areas receive enhanced landscaping services that are funded through additional tax assessments. There are 23 special districts throughout the City and over 12 million square feet of generally funded landscape parcels. Landscaping services are needed to maintain special district areas, including Capitol Auto Mall, Aborn / Murillo / Evergreen, Communication Hill / Dairy Hill, Communication Hill Pump Station / Adeline, Basking Ridge, Raleigh / Coronado, Los Paseos, Zanker / Plumeria / Montague, Bernal / Santa Teresa / Great Oaks, Karina / O'Neal, Silver Creek / Farnsworth / Larkspur / Yerba Buena, River Oaks / Crescent Village, Renaissance / North First, Hellyer / Silver Creek, and other generally funded areas such as Beautify SJ parcels.

In March 2025, a competitive Request for Bids was released by the Finance Department to procure these services. The Request for Bids included 17 different packages, 14 for special district areas and three for general fund areas. Bidders could bid on one or more packages. The Request for Bids provisioned for a one-year initial term and an additional six one-year options for the City to extend the term. Three responsive bids were submitted, and no protests were received. Bayscape Management, Inc. qualified for the City's local business preference. Staff recommends award to Bayscape Management, Inc., Brightview Landscape Services, Inc., and New Image Landscape Company as the lowest priced, responsive, and responsible bidders pursuant to the bidding procedures of the San José Municipal Code, Section 4.12.310B(1). Approval of this recommendation ensures the City continues to receive these essential services.
