A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE ADOPTING THE 370 TRIMBLE ROAD PLANNED DEVELOPMENT REZONING ADDENDUM TO THE NORTH SAN JOSE DEVELOPMENT POLICIES UPDATE FINAL PROGRAM ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT, THE ENVISION SAN JOSE 2040 GENERAL PLAN FINAL PROGRAM ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT SUPPLEMENTAL AND **ENVIRONMENTAL** IMPACT REPORT, AND ADDENDA THERETO, ALL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE **CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT. AS AMENDED**

WHEREAS, prior to the adoption of this Resolution, the Planning Director of the City of San José prepared and approved an Addendum to the Final Program Environmental Impact Report for the North San José Development Policies Update ("North San José FPEIR") under Planning File Nos. GP04-04-06A, GP04-04-06B, GPT04-04-06A, and GPT04-04-06B and City Council adopted Resolution No. 72768, the Final Program Environmental Impact Report for the Envision San José 2040 General Plan ("General Plan Update FPEIR") under Planning File No. PP09-011 and City Council adopted Resolution No. 76041, and Supplemental EIR ("SEIR") for the Envision San José 2040 General Plan, Greenhouse Gas Reduction Strategy under Planning File No. PP15-060 and City Council adopted Resolution No. 77617, and Addenda thereto, for the 370 Trimble Road Planned Development (PD) Rezoning Project under Planning File No. PDC17-026 (the "Project"), all in accordance with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, together with state and local guidelines implementing said Act, all as amended to date (collectively "CEQA"); and

WHEREAS, the City prepared, completed, and adopted in accordance with CEQA the North San José FPEIR, which analyzed the environmental impacts of future

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development in the revised North San José Development Policy Area for the

intensification of development; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San José certified said North San José FPEIR,

which certification was not appealed; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the adoption of a resolution approving said North

San José Development Policy Update, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 72768

on June 21, 2005, setting forth certain findings pertaining to the North San José FPEIR

and adopting a mitigation monitoring and reporting program, all pursuant to the

provisions of CEQA; and

WHEREAS, the City prepared, completed, and adopted in accordance with CEQA the

General Plan Update FPEIR, which analyzed the environmental impacts set forth from

the land use and development assumptions of the Envision San José General Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City certified said General Plan Update

FPEIR, which certification was not appealed; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the adoption of a resolution approving said Envision

San José 2040 General Plan (Planning File No. PP09-011), the City Council adopted

Resolution No. 76041 on November 1, 2011, setting forth certain findings pertaining to

the General Plan Update FPEIR and adopting a mitigation monitoring and reporting

program, all pursuant to the provisions of CEQA; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to said actions on the General Plan Update FPEIR, the City

prepared, completed, and adopted in accordance with CEQA the Supplemental EIR

("SEIR") to the Envision San José 2040 General Plan, Greenhouse Gas Reduction

Strategy (Planning File No. PP15-060); and

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WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City certified said SEIR, which certification

was not appealed; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the adoption of a resolution approving said SEIR to the

Envision San José 2040 General Plan Greenhouse Gas Reduction Strategy (Planning

File No. PP15-060), the City Council adopted Resolution No. 77617 on December 15,

2015 setting forth certain findings pertaining to the SEIR, all pursuant to the provisions

of CEQA; and

WHEREAS, prior to the adoption of this Resolution, the Planning Director of the City of

San José prepared and approved an Addendum to the North San José FPEIR, the

General Plan Update FPEIR and SEIR, and Addenda thereto for the 370 Trimble Road

PD Rezoning under Planning File No. PDC17-026 (the "Addendum"), all in accordance

with CEQA; and

WHEREAS, the 370 Trimble Road PD Rezoning (the "Project") analyzed under the

Addendum consists of Planned Development Rezoning from the Industrial Park IP

Planned Development (PD) Zoning District Planning File No. PDC93-017 to Industrial

Park IP Planned Development (PD) Zoning District Planning File No. PDC17-026 to

allow up to approximately 100,000 square feet for commercial uses and up to 250-room

hotel on an approximate 14.0-gross acre site located at the southwest corner of West

Trimble Road and Orchard Parkway, in San José, California; and

WHEREAS, as further described in the Addendum, the implementation of the Project

would not result in new significant effects on the environment beyond those already

identified in the previously approved the North San José FPEIR, the General Plan

Update FPEIR and SEIR, and Addenda thereto nor will the Project result in an increase

in the severity of significant effects identified in the North San José FPEIR, the General

Plan Update FPEIR and SEIR, and Addenda thereto; and

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WHEREAS, the City of San José is the lead agency on the Project, and the City Council

is the decision-making body for the proposed approval to undertake the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed and considered the North San José FPEIR,

the General Plan Update FPEIR and SEIR, and Addenda thereto and the Addendum

and intends to take actions on the Project in compliance with CEQA and state and local

guidelines implementing CEQA; and

WHEREAS, the Addendum to the North San José FPEIR, the General Plan Update

FPEIR and SEIR, and the Addenda thereto for the Project are on file in the Office of the

Director of Planning, located at 200 East Santa Clara Street, 3rd Floor Tower,

San José, California, 95113, are available for inspection by any interested person at

that location and are, by this reference, incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set

forth herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

SAN JOSE:

THAT THE CITY COUNCIL does hereby make the following findings: (1) it has

independently reviewed and analyzed the General Plan Update FPEIR and SEIR, as all

modified by the Addendum, as well as other information in the record and has

considered the information contained therein, prior to acting upon or approving the

Project, (2) the Addendum modifying the North San José FPEIR, General Plan Update

FPEIR and SEIR, and Addenda thereto prepared for the Project has been completed in

compliance with CEQA and is consistent with state and local guidelines implementing

CEQA, and (3) the Addendum modifying the North San José FPEIR, General Plan

Update FPEIR and SEIR, and Addenda thereto represents the independent judgment

and analysis of the City of San José, as lead agency for the Project. The City Council

designates the Director of Planning at the Director's Office at 200 East Santa Clara

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Street, 3rd Floor Tower, San José, California, 95113, as the custodian of documents

and records of proceedings on which this decision is based.

THAT THE CITY COUNCIL does hereby find that based upon the entire record of proceedings before it and all information received that there is no substantial evidence that the Project will have a significant effect on the environment and does hereby adopt the Addendum prepared for the Project (Planning File No. PDC17-026). The North San José FPEIR, General Plan Update FPEIR and SEIR, and Addenda thereto and the Addendum are: (1) on file in the Office of the Director of Planning, located at 200 East Santa Clara Street, 3rd Floor Tower, San José, California, 95113, and (2) available for inspection by any interested person.
