Some people who received this message don't often get email from Learn why this is important Dear Mayor Mahan, Councilmember Doan and Members of the City Council,

The D7 Leadership group represents the neighborhood associations and involved residents of District 7, and our mission is to advocate for a safer, cleaner and more beautiful community.

We support the definition of charter parks as written in the Director Jon Cicirelli's report and we appreciate the effort that has gone into this report. As you know, the Coyote Creek trail and Coyote Creek Park Chain runs through the length of D7, and we are pleased to see that not only the current parks, but also the Coyote Creek Trail, Los Lagos Golf Course and our three community centers are included in this definition.

However we do have several questions/concerns that we would like to see addressed.

How will the 24 foot restriction for trails affect maintenance in the areas where the trail is much wider than this limit? An example is where the trail splits at Yerba Buena and Grandbrook Ave, just past the Singleton landfill and before the switchbacks heading into Hellyer park.. (Possibly Mile 15 1/2 - the sign was vandalized and has not been replaced) The land extends at least 60 feet on either side of the trail. It has natural vegetation, and is currently maintained by PRNS. Will PRNS still maintain this land or will this become another border that residents need to navigate and advocate for?

Will the entirety of Kelley Park be chartered including the undeveloped part on the eastern side of the park near Roberts Road? Because this area is undeveloped we want to be sure that this area of the park is protected. We would not support any long-term repurposing of this section that would make it not a park.

Will the possible closure of Ramblewood School affect Ramblewood Park? We believe (but have not confirmed) that Franklin-McKinley School District leases the land for the school from the park and we are wondering if this will have any affect on the park.

Will Mariposa Park become a Chartered Park when the transaction between CalTrans and the city is concluded? We understand that Mariposa Park in the Tropicana-Lanai neighborhood is not considered a Chartered Park, because it is currently owned by CalTrans, but that is in the process of being acquired by the city according to the Chartered Park list?

What about undeveloped park land and future parks?


At the northern end of D7 along Coyote Creek is an unused parcel of land called Coyote Meadows. It is our hope that someday this land that surrounds the Coyote Creek Trail and the future Five Wounds Trail will become part of the Coyote Creek Park Chain. We would not expect this land to be designated as a Chartered Park, but we are hoping that it will be preserved for a future park. And there are other parcels of land in D7 and others throughout the city that neighbors are hoping might become a park someday and we wonder if this definition of chartered parks supports and protects future development of new parks, or if language needs to be added for this purpose.

The members of the D7 Leadership Group care deeply about our parks, trails, community centers and the open space of Los Lagos Golf Course and we urge the City Council to accept the report which we believe will protect these natural and important community areas.


