

RESOLUTION NO.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO: (A) AWARD AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE 9469 – WILLOW-KEYES CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE, RESPONSIBLE BIDDER IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$19,900,000, SUBJECT TO THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS; (B) DECIDE ANY TIMELY BID PROTEST(S) AND MAKE THE CITY’S FINAL DETERMINATION AS TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER THAT IS RESPONSIBLE AS NEEDED TO AWARD THE CONTRACT; AND (C) APPROVE A CONTINGENCY OF UP TO 10% OF THE CONTRACT AMOUNT**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of San José (“City”) desires to adopt this resolution for the reasons set forth in the memorandum, dated May 26, 2026, from John Ristow, the Director of Transportation, and Matt Loesch, the Director of Public Works, for the June 23, 2026 City Council meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, this action will expedite the contract process ensuring the 9469 – Willow-Keyes Corridor Improvements Project is awarded by the September 2026 federal granting agency’s delivery deadline;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to:

- A. Award and execute a contract for the construction of the 9469 – Willow-Keyes Corridor Improvements Project to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder in an amount not to exceed \$19,900,000, subject to the appropriation of funds; and

- B. Decide any timely bid protest(s) and make the City’s final determination as to the lowest responsive bidder that is responsible as needed to award the contract;  
and
- C. Approve a contingency of up to 10% of the contract amount.
