RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The End of Term Celebration will be held on Thursday, December 15, 2022 at SP2 Communal Bar + Restaurant and is sponsored by Councilmember Raul Perez. This special event will bring together the District 3 team and community members to celebrate and recognize the 8 years of dedication and commitment to representing and supporting the neighborhoods surrounding and located throughout the District 3 boundaries.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Raul Peralez will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 3, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
