**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE ACCEPTING THE 2020 INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN TASK FORCE INVITED AWARDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$521,869 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT AND ALL ADDITIONAL AMENDMENTS AND ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS, INCLUDING ONLINE CERTIFICATIONS AT TIME OF REIMBURSEMENT REQUEST, WITHOUT FURTHER CITY COUNCIL ACTION**

**WHEREAS**, in 1998, the U.S. Department of Justice’s Office of Juvenile Justice Delinquency and Prevention (“OJJDP”) created the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force (“ICAC”) Program in response to the increasing number of children and teenagers using the Internet, the rapid increase in numbers of child sexual abuse images available electronically, and intensified online activities by predators seeking unsupervised contact with children; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of San José Police Department (“Department”) recognized the need to protect the children in the community in a fast-growing trend of Internet uses and various social media platforms, and in February 2003, the Department applied for and was awarded its first ICAC grant from the OJJDP; and

**WHEREAS**, since then, the Department has applied for and received several ICAC continuation grants, which has provided overtime, equipment, and vehicles for investigations; training of investigators; and opportunities for two national ICAC trainings in a year; and

**WHEREAS**, funding has also provided equipment and training for investigators from 11 Bay Area counties who participate in the Silicon Valley Internet Crimes Against Children (“SVICAC”) Task Force as the Department serves as the Fiscal Agent for this regional award; and

**WHEREAS**, in June 2020, OJJDP invited the Department to apply for the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 grant and the application was accepted and approved in the amount of \$521,869; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to accept the 2020 Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Invited Award in the amount of \$521,869, with a grant term of October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021, to provide critical funding to the Department as it will continue to support and strengthen resources for the SVICAC Task Force;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

1. The 2020 Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Invited Awards in the amount of \$521,869 is hereby accepted.
2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Grant Agreement and to execute additional amendments and all related documents, including online certifications at time of reimbursement request, without further City Council action.
