BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Halloween Spooktacular will be held on October 27th, 2018 at the Evergreen Community Center on San Felipe Road, San Jose, from 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. This special event is a community building event that includes carnival games, pumpkin patch, haunted house, arts & crafts, a magic show, and more. The event is free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Arenas will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the
