BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Silicon Valley Organization District 4 Merchant Walk was held on October 4th, 2017, will begin at The Silicon Valley Organization at 101 W. Santa Clara St. and then transition to the sites of various businesses in District 4. It is being sponsored by Councilmember Lan Diep. This special event aimed to improve connectivity and outreach from the City to businesses in District 4.
