

FAST Pilot Program Overview


- Explore Proactive, Expedited Blight Enforcement Model
- Six Focus Areas
- Components:
 - Targeted Outreach and Education
 - Proactive Inspection
 - Expedited Enforcement
- Duration: August 2023 to July 2024
- Cost: 303k, 3,072 staff hours

If your vehicle isn't working, repair it or store it in a garage. You can also store it in a side yard or backyard where it's not visible from the street, at least five feet from the property line or fence. It cannot block access to any begrean windows.

Municipal Code 17.72.600. Fine Amount: \$100


