RECOMMENDATION

1. Approve Meadowfair Neighborhood Cleanup scheduled on Saturday, June 11, 2022 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups to support the event.
3. Place the item on the Tuesday, June 7, 2022 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Meadowfair Neighborhood Cleanup will be held on Saturday, June 11, 2022 at the Meadowfair Community Center and sponsored by Councilmember Arenas. This special event is a cleanup of Meadowfair neighborhood streets by volunteers. The event is free and open to the public and will follow all appropriate local public health rules.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure
