

Funding Status



- Currently in New Starts
 Engineering (NSE) Phase of
 FTA's Capital Investment
 Grant Program
- Cost saving effort underway
- Exploring up to \$100M nonlocal funding sources including:
 - Solutions for Congested Corridors Program (SCCP)
 - SB1 Local Assistance Program



Program Considerations



- \$ Cost Savings (between \$700M to \$1.2B)
- Contractor/Industry confidence to build BSVII within budget
- Path to signing FFGA, before award of CP2 Stage 2





Overview of Planned Demolition





- Demolition of Gross/Holmes and Goodlife buildings to occur in 2025.
- Considering postponing demolition of Chase Bank and Goldrock buildings until late 2026.
- VTA provided \$150k to San José Downtown Association to fund the beautification effort along Santa Clara Street.
