2. Allocate an amount not to exceed \$6,250,000 for the duration of the grant,

subject to the appropriation of funds, as the local matching funds required for

HMPG.

3. Negotiate and execute the HMPG program application package, including a

not to exceed \$25,000,000, as well as all other documents required or deemed
