SUBJECT: UPDATE TO THE JANUARY – JUNE 2023 COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE WORK PLAN

RECOMMENDATION

Approve an amendment to the January – June 2023 Community and Economic Development (CED) Committee Work Plan to drop the following item from the April 24, 2023, CED Committee meeting:

As part of its action on Quick-Build/Emergency Interim Housing on June 21, 2022, the City Council directed the Administration to report back to the CED Committee in spring 2023 with a progress report.
