On behalf of the Silicon Valley Leadership Group, I express our strong support for the recommendation for the City of San Jose to take a position of support for the Veterans and Affordable Housing Bond on the November 6 statewide ballot.

The Leadership Group is proud to be co-leading the campaign along with Housing California, California Housing Consortium, and the State Building and Construction Trades Council of California. The Leadership Group successfully coled the past two statewide housing bonds and we are honored to again co-lead a statewide housing bond campaign for much-needed affordable housing funding that can be leverage many times over with federal and local funding.
