City Council Study Session

Purpose: To provide the City Council with an overview of the San José-Santa Clara Regional Wastewater Facility (RWF) Plant Master Plan, discuss the issues affecting the RWF since the adoption of the Plant Master Plan; provide details on the Capital Improvement Program's effort to update the Plant Master Plan's Technical Component, which will be brought to the City Council in mid-2025; and provide an update on various projects on or around the RWF land.

Outcome: The City Council will have a comprehensive understanding of the Plant Master Plan, issues currently affecting the RWF, the update to the Plant Master Plan's Technical Component, and projects being constructed on RWF land.

Mariana Chavez-Vazquez, Regional Wastewater Facility General Manager, Environmental Services Department; Kapil Verma, Deputy Director, Environmental Services Department; Kevin Ice, Assistant to the City Manager, Office of the City Manager; Lori Mitchell, Acting Director, Environmental Services Department; and Jeff Provenzano, Assistant Director, Environmental Services Department offered the presentation and responded to questions. Presentation topics included: an overview of the Regional Wastewater Facility, background on the Plant Master Plan, Capital Improvement Program accomplishments, new nutrient limit regulations, a Plant Master Plan technical update, an update on the Shoreline Levee Project, an update on RWF land use, and a flow study.


Public Comment
