SUBJECT: APPROVE TRASH TALK SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 6 AS A CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT

RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Approve the community office hour Trash Talk scheduled on August 27th, 2022, as a City Council sponsored Special Events and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups that support the events.
- 3. Place the item on the August 30, 2022, Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Trash Talk will be held on August 27th, 2022, at 520 W Virginia St, San Jose, CA 95125 and is sponsored by Councilmember Dev Davis. This special event is an opportunity for residents to discuss concerns with Councilmember Dev Davis while cleaning-up the streets of District 6. The event is free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the events will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Dev Davis will report any cash or in-kind donations received for

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the events on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 6, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the events. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
