**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING “FREE USE” FOR ACTIVITIES HELD AT CITY HALL ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 30, 2021 FOR A COMMUNITY VACCINATION EVENT**

**WHEREAS**, in June 2016, the City adopted Schedule of Fees Resolution No. 77829 for the fees and charges for City Hall Facility and Plaza Use; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 77829 authorizes City Departments to have “Free Use” of the facilities for those events that 1) qualify as official City business; 2) are free and open to the public; 3) occur on a Sunday through Friday; and 4) are booked thirty (30) days in advance; and

**WHEREAS**, “Free Use” does not apply to Saturday events, and, therefore, Council approval is necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, the City’s Emergency Operations Center, in coordination with the Office of Emergency Management, has requested that “Free Use” be authorized for Saturday, October 30, 2021 to offer a free COVID-19 and influenza drop-in vaccination clinic to the general public, with a specific focus on the unhoused; and

**WHEREAS**, the City finds that the event qualifies as official City business by providing a location large enough to safely and comfortably accommodate the number of participants expected to attend; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to allow for the free use of the City Hall Rotunda for a community vaccination event on Saturday, October 30, 2021 to allow members of the general public who may be working or attending school during the week to attend;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Council hereby retroactively authorizes “Free Use” of the City Hall Rotunda for a community vaccination event on Saturday, October 30, 2021.
