SUBJECT: RETROACTIVE APPROVAL OF ARCADIA BALLPARK OPEN HOUSE COMMUNITY EVENT SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 8 AS A CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT

RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Retroactively approve Arcadia Ballpark Open House scheduled on Saturday, July 17, 2021 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups to support the event.
- 3. Place the item on the Tuesday, August 3, 2021 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Arcadia Ballpark Open House will be held on Saturday, July 17, 2021 at Arcadia Ballpark and sponsored by Councilmember Arenas. This special event is a celebration of the Grand Opening of the Arcadia Ballpark. Guests will have full access to the facility, playground, and mini field and the event will feature resource tables and refreshments. City staff will be available to answer questions. The event is free and open to the public and will follow all appropriate local public health rules, including requiring masks and social distancing.

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ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Arenas will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 8, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
